

The Ellen Clark Revelle Scholarship The "Nellie"

Scripps College is pleased to offer the "Nellie," an innovative and transformative scholarship honoring the alumna and former trustee Ellen Clark Revelle '31. This scholarship is available to a continuing student who is making excellent academic progress, demonstrates financial need, and who fully engages in leadership activities in the Scripps College community and beyond.

Designated an *Ellen Clark Revelle Scholar*, the recipient of this award will receive an \$800 book stipend as well as a \$5,000 summer internship stipend to pursue further leadership experience. At graduation, the Ellen Clark Revelle Scholarship Fund will repay any packaged amount of need-based loan that the student borrows, up to a maximum of \$14,000.

The Revelle Scholar may also request additional funds for other educationally related expenses, including a laptop computer, two round-trip airfares home annually, and funding for student health insurance. The Ellen Clark Revelle Scholarship is automatically renewable for a maximum of six semesters, assuming the recipient maintains high academic standards and continues to be engaged with the Scripps College community and the community-at-large.

Eligibility

Applicants must be currently enrolled undergraduate students at Scripps College who demonstrate financial need.

Application Process

Applications and all supporting documentation are due to Career Planning & Resources via email by 11:59 p.m. on April 6, 2014. This includes:

- 1. An applicant form, signed and dated
- 2. A personal statement describing leadership activities and impact
- 3. A faculty recommendation letter
- 4. A personal recommendation letter attesting to leadership qualities and abilities

Completed applications and personal statements should be saved as a PDF and sent electronically to <u>careers@scrippscollege.edu</u> with the subject line "[Last Name] Nellie Application." Faculty and personal recommendations should be emailed separately by the recommender to the same address.

All materials are due by 11:59 p.m. on April 6, 2014. Incomplete or late applications will not be accepted.

Finalists will be invited for an interview with the selection committee. The scholarship recipient will be invited to and expected to attend the annual Scholarship Luncheon in the spring.
