### **Aug 1 – [Fulbright Scholars](#)**

The Core Fulbright Scholar Program offers over 500 teaching, research or combination teaching/research awards in over 125 countries. Opportunities are available for college and university faculty and administrators as well as for professionals, artists, journalists, scientists, lawyers, independent scholars and many others. In addition to several new program models designed to meet the changing needs of U.S. academics and professionals, Fulbright is offering more opportunities for flexible, multi-country grants. Grant duration ranges from 2-12 months.

### **Sept 19 – [Guggenheim Fellowships](#)**

The John Simon Guggenheim Memorial Foundation provides approximately 200 fellowships/year for advanced professionals in all fields — including the natural sciences, social sciences, humanities, and creative arts — except the performing arts. The program seeks to further the development of scholars and artists by helping them engage in research in any field of knowledge and/or creation in any of the arts under the freest possible conditions.

Fellowships available to artists and scholars for between 6 and 12 months. *Grant amounts vary.* Intended for individuals who have already demonstrated exceptional capacity for productive scholarship or exceptional creative ability in the arts.

***NEW!*** [Radcliffe Institute Fellowships](#) at Harvard University

The Radcliffe Institute for Advanced Study at Harvard University is accepting applications for its 2018-2019 Fellowship Program

Through the program, stipends of *up to \$77,500* for one year with additional funds for project expenses will be awarded to individuals working in the creative arts, humanities, social sciences, natural sciences, and mathematics to pursue projects within their fields. In addition, some support for relocation expenses is provided where relevant.

In addition to the stipend, fellows receive office or studio space and access to libraries and other resources of Harvard University during the fellowship year, which runs from early September 2018 through May 31, 2019. Visual, film, and video artists may apply for either one or two semesters. In the event that they come for one semester, the stipend is \$38,750.

Radcliffe Fellows are expected to devote themselves full time to the work outlined in their proposal. Since this is a residential fellowship, fellows are expected to reside in the Boston area the fellowship period and to have their primary office at the institute to participate fully in the life of the community.

The deadline for individual applications in the creative arts, humanities, and social sciences is September 14, 2017. For applications in the natural sciences and mathematics, the deadline is October 5, 2017.

## **Rolling** – [Robert Wood Johnson Foundation](#)

The Robert Wood Johnson Foundation is accepting Letters of Intent for its *Evidence for Action: Investigator-Initiated Research to Build a Culture of Health*. The program aims to provide individuals, organizations, communities, policy makers, and researchers with the empirical evidence needed to address the key determinants of health encompassed in the Culture of Health Action Framework. Evidence for Action encourages creative, rigorous research on the impact of innovative programs, policies and partnerships on health and well-being, and on novel approaches to measuring health determinants and outcomes. Grants range from \$46,000 to \$500,000. Generally, applicants can expect to be notified within 6-8 of submitting their Letters of Intent. Applicants invited to the full proposal stage will have 2 months to submit their proposal once they receive notification. Full proposal funding decisions generally will be made within 6-8 weeks of the submission deadline.

## **NEW!** [Rome Prize](#) for Arts and Humanities

Awarded annually to thirty artists and scholars in the early or middle stages of their careers who exemplify the highest standard of excellence in arts and humanities scholarship. Fellows are chosen from the disciplines of architecture, design, historic



preservation and conservation, landscape architecture, literature, musical composition, visual arts, ancient studies, medieval studies, Renaissance and Early Modern studies, and Modern Italian studies. Each prize winner is provided with a stipend, meals, a bedroom with private bath, and a study or studio.
