



AP/IB Credit and Language Waiver

Here are a few helpful hints when reviewing your transcript.

Advanced Placement and International Baccalaureate Course Credit:

AP Calculus AB or BC score of 4 or 5 satisfies the Scripps math GE. Aside from this, AP and IB credit is elective credit only; it does not satisfy any other general education or major/minor requirements. A maximum of four course credits may be awarded for AP/IB scores.

Course credit is awarded to students whose AP scores of 4 or 5, IB Higher Level scores of 5, 6, or 7, are accompanied by a corresponding high school course listed on the final official high school transcript. The high school course must identify AP or IB in its title for credit to be applied.

If you meet these conditions and your AP/IB scores and high school transcripts are on file, course credit has been recorded on your Scripps transcript, which is visible on the portal Student tab under “Unofficial Transcript”. Contact the Registrar’s Office if you have questions.

SAT Subject Test Foreign Language Waiver:

Students whose SAT Subject Test score for a language other than English is at or above the following are waived of the foreign language general education requirement; a waiver is recorded on your transcript:

Chinese	630

German	630
Latin	630
Modern Hebrew	540
Spanish	630

If your official score report is not on file with the Scripps Registrar, contact the College Board to request that it be sent to Scripps College. The Scripps College code is 4693.

Primary language other than English:

A student may petition for a waiver of the requirement upon obtaining written verification of proficiency equivalent to third College semester (intermediate level) from a Claremont faculty member fluent in the student’s language of proficiency. A language waiver carries no course credit.
