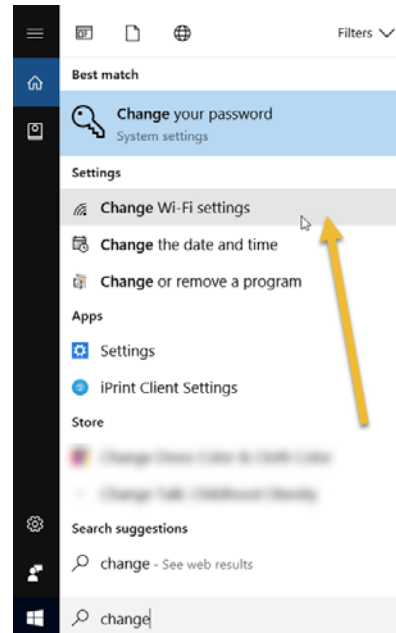


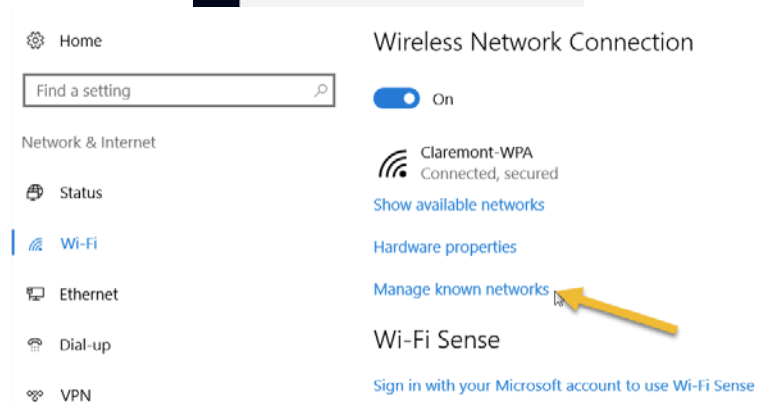
Connecting to Claremont-WPA on Windows 10

1. Restart the device.

2. Go down to the start menu and type “Change” and search for “Change Wi-Fi Settings” and click it to open it.



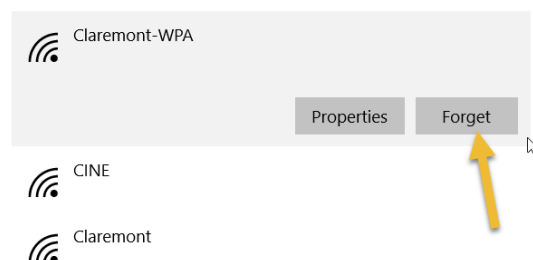
3. Click on “Manage known networks”



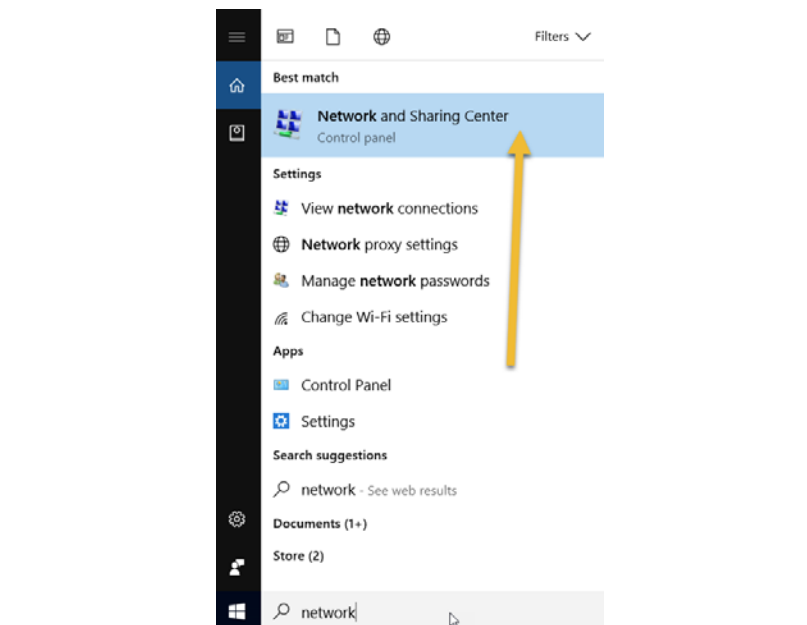
4. Locate “Claremont-WPA” and click it once, then click the “Forget” button. If you cannot locate “Claremont-WPA” ignore this step and move onto the next step.

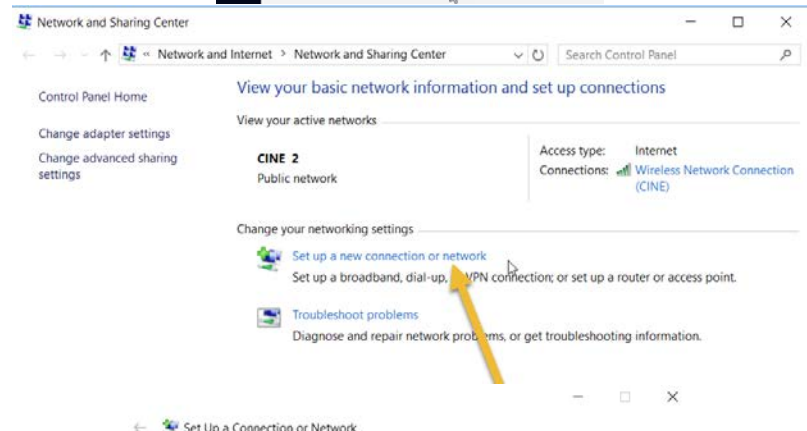

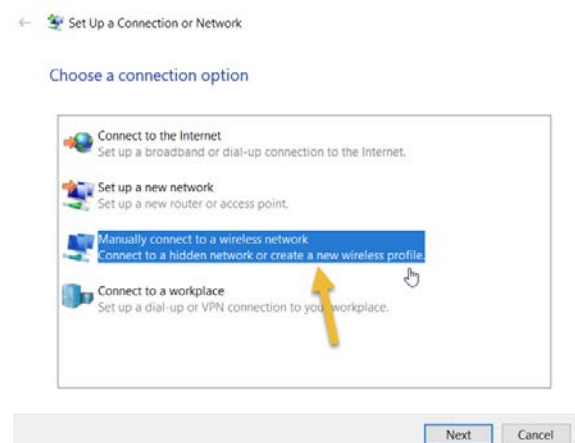
5. Close all previous windows. Go down to the start menu and type “Network” and search for “Network and Charing Center” and click it to open it.



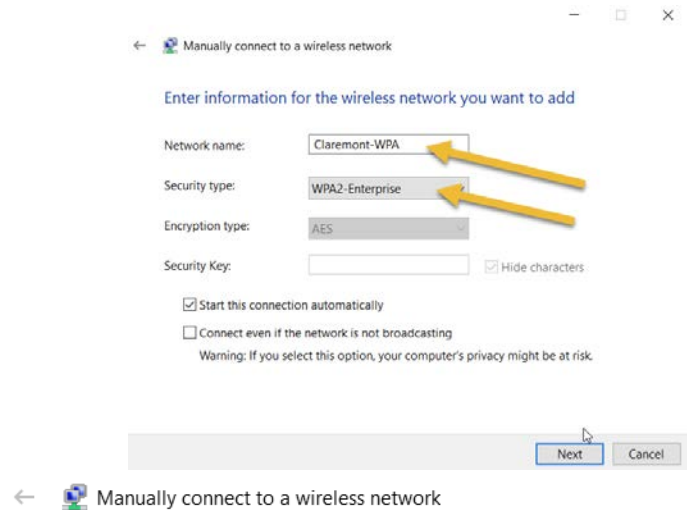
6. Please click on “Set up a new connection or network”



7. Then, please click on “Manually connect to a wireless network” and click “next”.



8. Next, please type in “Claremont-WPA” in the network name field. Also, select “WPA2-Enterprise” in the security type drop down, then click “next”

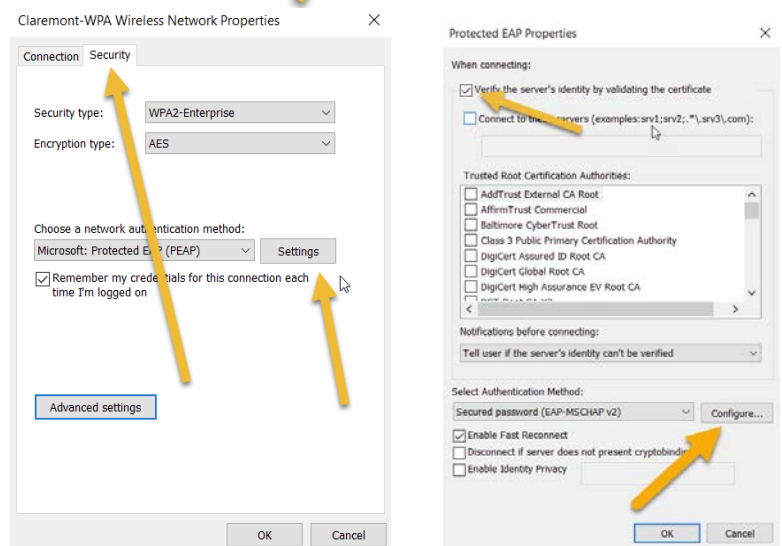


9. Please click “Change connection settings”

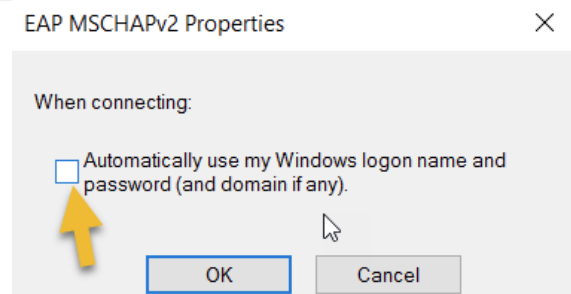

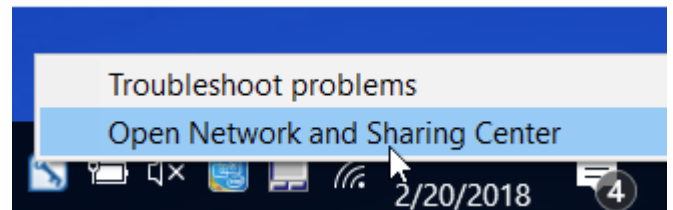
10. Click the security tab, then “settings”. Then, UNCHECK “Verify the server...” and click “Configure”.



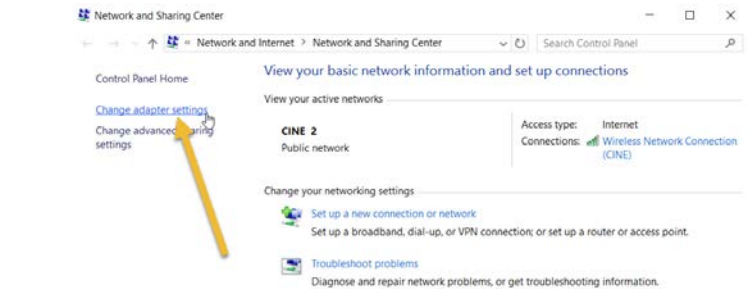
11. Next, please verify that the box is UNCHECKED for “Automatically use my Windows logon name and password”. Then click, Ok, Ok, and Ok, and close any Windows that are still open.



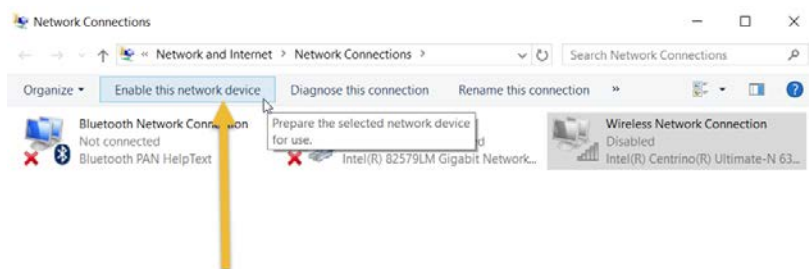
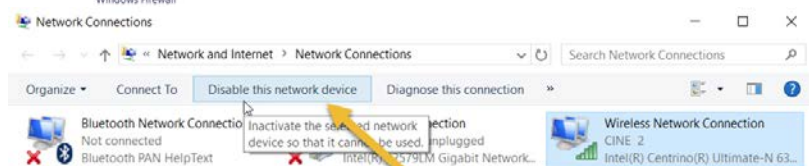
12. Next, please go down to the “Tray” by the clock and **right click** the WiFi symbol and select “Open Network and Sharing Center”



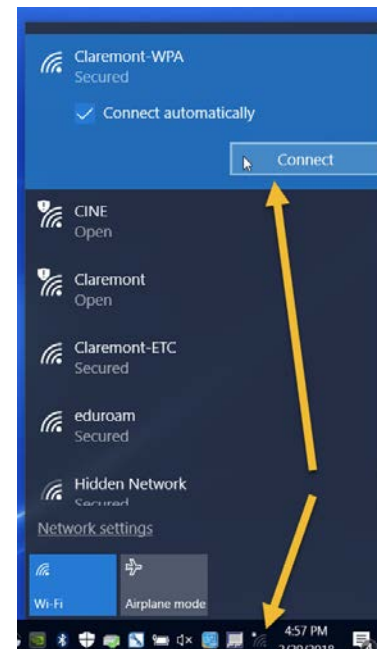
13. Next, please select “Change Adapter Settings” in the left pane



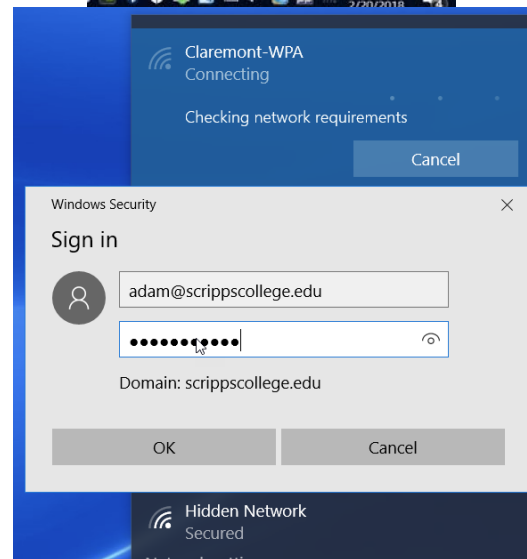
14. Now, we are going to disable and then enable the “Wireless Network Connection”. Please wait about 5 seconds in between disabling and enabling this connection.



15. Next, please close the network connections window and left click on the WiFi symbol in the “Tray” down by the clock. Please click “Claremont-WPA” and then, “Connect”



16. Lastly, please allow 5 or so seconds for this next window to popup. This will now prompt you for your full scrippscollege.edu email address and network password.
